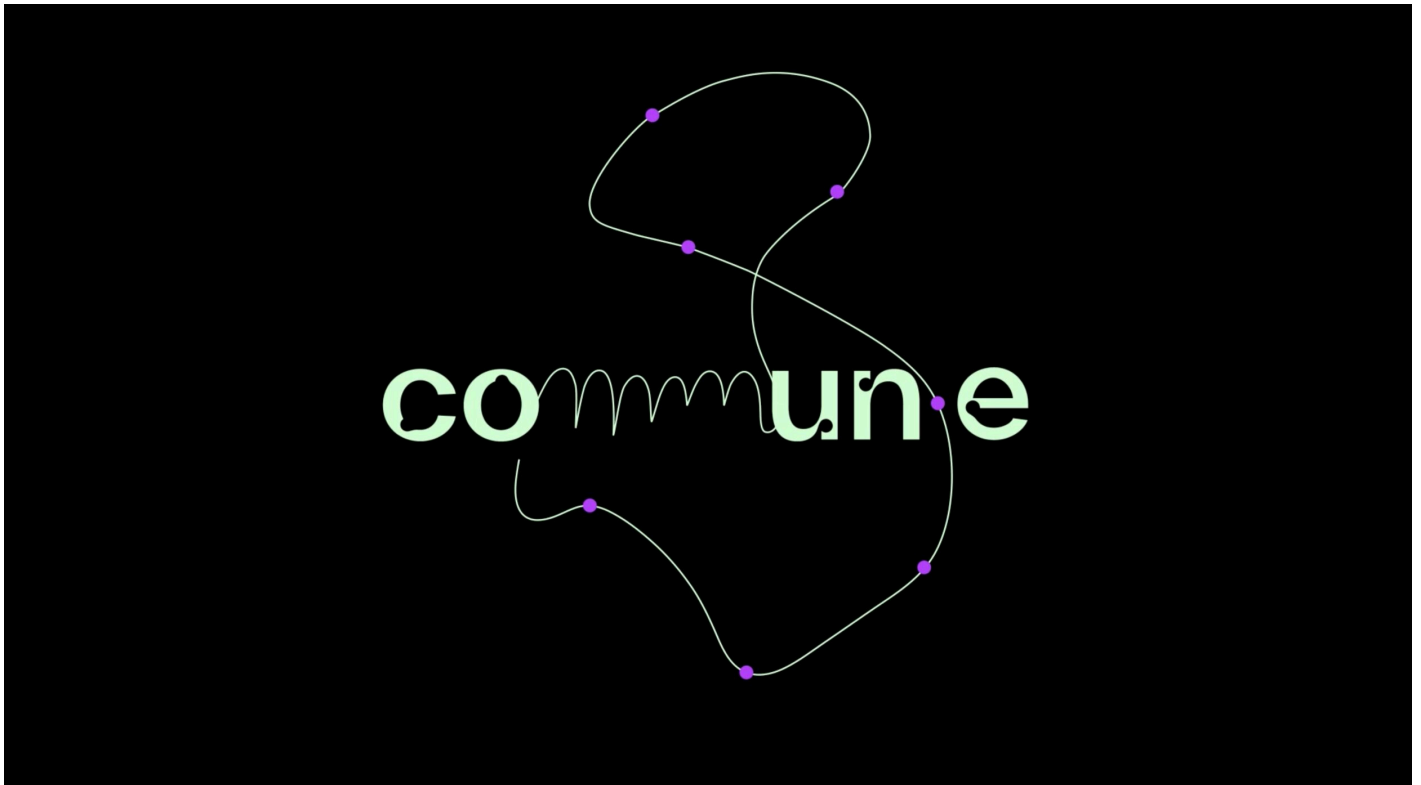

Conceived within the framework of Africa2020, Commun.e was initiated by Triangle – Astérides and the Triangle Network, who invited South African artist and curator Ziphosenkosi Dayile and the Breaking Bread collective to develop a project unfolding both in Marseille and online.

Within this framework, Vir Andres Hera entered into dialogue with Ziphzenkosi Dayile and Flora Fettah through a working method structured by return, circulation and repositioning. Rather than presenting a closed work, the contribution operated as a situated exchange, foregrounding collective articulation over singular authorship. What began as an institutional invitation developed into a sustained collaboration, marking the beginning of an ongoing artistic dialogue between Hera, Dayile and Fettah.
