

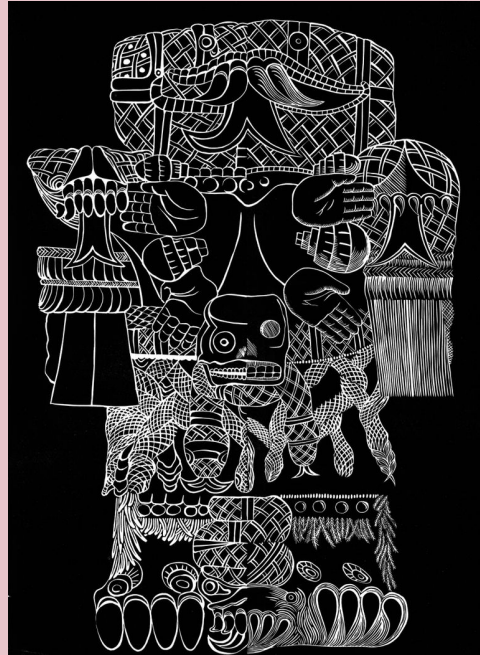
Vir Andres Hera

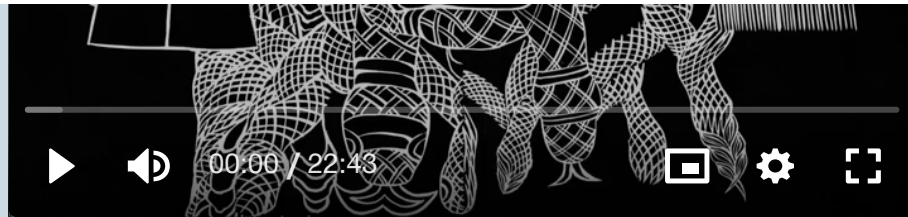
